Important Information:

CMS Recycling is an essential business and currently remains open to serve our industrial customers and community. We are taking proactive steps to maintain the continuity of business operations while addressing societal and individual health concerns.

In our continued efforts to maintain a safe workplace and keep our employees, customers, visitors, suppliers and community safe, we wanted to share the latest news on how we are maintaining a clean facility and safe recycling experience for everyone. Below are the steps CMS is putting in place to help "flatten the curve" and stop the spread of this virus while being open for business.

- We kindly ask you to not enter our business if you are sick or feel you have come in contact with someone who is sick.
- Use required (6) feet social distancing and refrain from contact of any kind.
- You are required to wear a face mask while on our property.
- Our employees will be wearing face masks, gloves and will be changing them frequently.
- Workstations and high traffic zones will be sanitized at minimum on an hourly basis.
- We will limit the amount of people allowed in the lobby to (1) at a time.
- We ask you NOT to bring additional people (including children or individuals 65 years or older) while recycling to limit the amount of people on site.
- Daily cash limit of \$400 per person, checks will be issued for amounts over \$400.
- We are observing & monitoring recommended protocols from the CDC.
